What is Love and Logic?

Love and Logic is a philosophy of raising and teaching children which many parents and teachers have found very helpful. They report that it allows adults to be happier, empowered and more skilled in their interactions with children.

Who will benefit from these classes?

Anyone who loves or works with children -- parents, foster parents, grandparents, day care providers, family support professionals, coaches and teachers with children of all ages (infants, school-aged, teenagers & beyond).



What about our kids?

The whole family is invited to come to camp and enjoy the weekend. While the parents are in the sessions led by the facilitators, camp program staff will lead the kids in other age-appropriate activities like Bible studies, crafts, games, singing, etc. When parents are not in sessions, families will have some free time as well as opportunities for family activities hosted by the staff.

When do we arrive / depart?

Registration will be on Friday night from 6:30-7:30 p.m. The first introduction session will be at 7:30. The retreat will conclude after a worship service and a 10:30 brunch on Sunday.

- *"How do I get them out of bed in time to catch the school bus?"*
- *"How can I stop my children from bickering and fighting?"*
- *"How do I get my children to help with the chores without an argument?"*
- *"Is there a way to discipline my toddler in public without creating a scene?"*

- *"How do I get him to stop spitting his peas and whining at dinner?"*
- *And many other day-to-day parenting challenges . . .*

Families will be housed in hotel-style lodging, with a bathroom in each room for quick accessibility. If you are from nearby and do not wish to stay overnight at the camp, a reduced fee is available.
