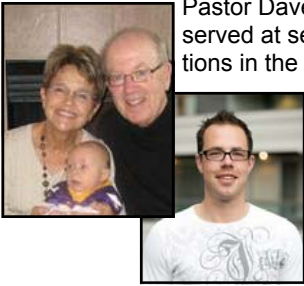


2012 Family Camp Speakers
