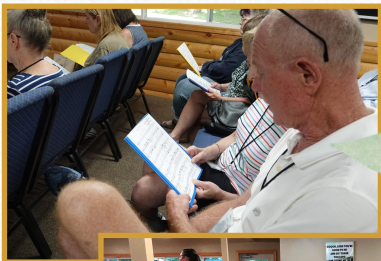

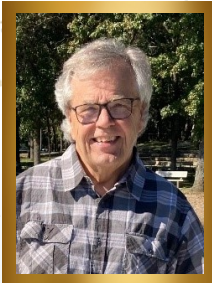

SPEAKER: REV. JOHN PETERSEN

John R. Petersen was ordained in 1975 at his home congregation in Ringsted, IA. John and, his wife, Ellen served churches in Denver, CO, Blair, NE, Milford, IA and for the past 27 years in Mankato, MN. While serving at First Lutheran in Milford, John also served on the Ingham-Okoboji Lutheran Bible Camps board of directors. He retired as Senior Pastor of Christ the King Lutheran Church in Mankato in 2014 and returned 12 months later as a part-time staff member which he continues to do today. He and Ellen exchanged wedding vows at St. Peter Lutheran Church in Ceylon, MN on June 19, 1971. They have two daughters, Rachel and Jessica and their families that consist of seven grandchildren.
