Monday  (Gabby)	<b>Abba (Our Father)</b>  Galatians 4:6 (NIV)	Matthew 19:13-15/Mark 10:13-16/Luke 18:15-17 (let the children approach me)	God reveals Himself as a relational God, giving us a sense of belonging when He adopts us into His family. By calling himself Abba (Father), God invites us to approach him with a child-like faith and trust. Tuesday  (Peej)	<b>Jehovah Tsidkenu (Our Righteousness)</b>  2 Corinthians 5:21 (NCV)	Luke 18:9-14 (Pharisee & tax collector parable)	The LORD’s heart breaks when He sees His children separated from Him because of sin. Knowing we could never make ourselves righteous on our own, the LORD in His goodness sends His own son in our place to be our righteousness and redeem us back to Him. Wednesday  (Gabby)	<b>Jehovah Jireh (Our Provider)</b>  Acts 14:17b (NIV)	Exodus 16 (Manna and Quail)	The LORD delights in our dependence. By trusting in Him, we honor Him as our provider. Jesus repeatedly teaches us not to worry about our needs, but to trust in God who will provide for them. God never promises to give us everything we want, but He does promise to give us everything we need to do whatever He has called us to do. Thursday  (Kristin)	<b>Adonai Tzva’ot (Lord of Hosts)</b>  Psalm 118:6 (GNT)	2 Chronicles 20:1-30 (Jehoshaphat)	God has complete authority over everything seen and unseen. The name “Lord of Hosts” reveals God’s command over all the armies of heaven and earth. The Lord of Hosts is FOR US, and fights FOR US. God is our refuge, our fortress, our shield, our defender. Sunday/ Friday  (Dan)	<b>YHWH (I Am)</b>  Psalm 135:13 (NIV)	Exodus 3:1-14 (Burning Bush) Exodus 34 John 18:1-6 (arrest where “I am” is spoken)	God reveals his name to Moses as “I Am who I Am.” It’s a statement of the eternal existence of an everlasting God, who was, and is, and is to come. While speaking to the Pharisees, Jesus used this name for himself, revealing his unity with God the Father (John 8:58).
