Greetings from camp! Whether you are striving for excellence at school or working hard at your current job, we hope this letter finds you seeking the Lord in your life. Wherever you are at this time in life, please know that your work here in the past continues to make a difference in the lives of the campers that came through the gates of the camp! Thanks! We appreciate you!

Preparations are being made to hire the staff for the upcoming summer ministries. As you know it is our goal to have a Christ centered staff committed to the Lord's service. We are thankful for the time that you have spent with us, and we hope that you will prayerfully consider another summer serving the Lord at Ingham Okoboji. Our 2024 Summer Theme is "Cultivate Life" based on John 15:5. "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." When we recognize God in His rightful place, space is created for God to cultivate our faith. We will explore what various areas of our lives may look like when we yield to the Holy Spirit in order to grow our character and bear fruit for the world around us.

We also want to remind everyone that we always need lifeguards. You can be certified FREE if you come to lifeguard training May 19-25, the week before staff training. Simple prerequisites for lifeguard training include a 300yd swim, brick retrieval, and treading water. (The costs for the week of lifeguard training are paid for by the camp). *Lifeguards also receive a **\$220 bonus (\$20/wk)** for the summer. Please consider it and sign up!*

Every returning staff member has to apply—applications will be acted upon as they are received, so the earlier you complete the application, the earlier we can process the application. *As a reminder, each part of the application process can be done online!*

This returning counselor application is also the application for leadership positions. I encourage every person interested in serving in a specific leadership or support position to apply for it. Knowing that there are a limited number of positions, we pray that God would put the right people in leadership, counselor, and support roles to form the team that would serve Him most fully. Returning counselor apps can be received anytime, however **applications for leadership positions must be received by Sunday, November 26.**

First year Senior Staff members will earn a \$2,750 salary for the summer (\$250/week). Returning Senior Staff members will make \$3,025 (\$275/week). Day Camp Leaders and Program Directors earn up to \$3,600 (\$300/week). Staff are hired for 11 weeks, beginning with staff training on May 25, and ending on August 11, the last day of camp. Leadership training begins May 19.

Returning/Leadership Job Description Summaries

Senior Counselor: \$250/wk in first year, \$275/wk returning

Senior Counselors are responsible for leading a small group of campers through all daily activities of camp life including worship, Bible Studies, evening devotions, games, hikes, dish crew, etc. Senior Counselors are expected to spend time with the kids and families, provide constant supervision to the small group, ensure safety, and create a welcoming community for all. The goal is to create a unified staff team, who are flexible and responsible to adapt to the leading of the Holy Spirit and campers' needs and who prayerfully support each other and campers. Senior Counselors are privileged to let God work through them to impact the campers so they may "know Jesus Christ and make Christ known to all."

Paintball and Recreation Director: \$250/wk in first year, \$275/wk returning

The Paintball and Recreation Director is responsible first and foremost for overseeing our paintball program offered at both Ingham and Okoboji. This position requires transporting Okoboji staff and campers to and from the paintball experience. Secondly the Paintball and Recreation Director is responsible for promoting and providing a variety of exciting recreation options at Okoboji, leading them whenever available. The goal is to create a unified staff team, who are flexible and responsible to adapt to the leading of the Holy Spirit and campers' needs and who prayerfully support each other and campers. This role is an important part of engaging campers in the overall camp experience, so that they may "know Jesus Christ and make Christ known to all."

Day Camp Leader: \$300/wk

Day Camp Leaders lead a team of counselors to put on Day Camps (VBS) each week at participating churches. These churches are primarily within a 4 hour driving distance from camp. This includes communication with the local directors at participating churches prior to the week of Day Camp to make sure everything is in order, get final numbers, etc. It also includes preparing all day camp supplies prior to departure (i.e. skit props, craft supplies, etc.). The goal is to create a unified staff team, who are flexible and responsible to adapt to the leading of the Holy Spirit and campers' needs and who prayerfully support each other and campers. Day Camp Leaders are privileged to let God work through them in this outreach ministry of the camps as we seek "To know Jesus Christ and to make Christ known to all."

Program Director: \$300/wk

The summer Program Directors at both Ingham and Okoboji help full-time leadership lead staff training, including announcements, transitions, giving talks during training sessions, organizing activities, etc. They are also the key people to lead summer staff through each week of on-site programming. These individuals help oversee and ensure quality programming and appropriate behavior among staff and campers. The goal is to create a unified staff team, who are flexible and responsible to adapt to the leading of the Holy Spirit and campers' needs and who prayerfully support each other and campers. Program Directors are privileged to let God work through them to disciple staff and impact campers so they may "know Jesus Christ and make Christ known to all."

***As part of our hospitality to guests, all staff members participate in cleaning and maintaining the camp at the beginning and end of every week of camp. This team effort requires positive attitudes, encouragement for team members, and a hard work ethic. It makes a big difference in creating a welcoming atmosphere for guests.*
