DR. FRED BALTZ



Dr. Fred Baltz is Pastor Emeritus of St. Matthew Lutheran Church, Galena, Illinois, where he served as Pastor for 40 years. He is an author of confirmation curriculum, many articles and more than a dozen books, and has also contributed to documentary films, web articles, and podcasts. Dr. Baltz has given presentations to three international conferences on the Shroud of Turin. He has also taught for the Institute of Lutheran Theology in Brookings, South Dakota, and served as its interim president in 2011. Dr. Baltz has long attempted to make the Bible come alive for his hearers. He has built and collected unique items for that purpose. Dr. Baltz and Cindy continue to reside in Galena, Illinois. They have four children and seven grandchildren.

THEME: "These are the Names..." The Book of Exodus for Christians

"These are the Names," That's how the Book of Exodus begins, with names of real people who experienced real events in real time. The Exodus from Egypt is the greatest story of deliverance in the Old Testament, and it contributes mightily to our appreciation of the New Testament's great deliverance story, the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We will address how the Christian should regard Moses; the plagues on Egypt; the Passover; the golden calf; the wilderness wandering; the manna and the water from the rock. We will also discuss the Ark of the Covenant and the Tabernacle for what they have to tell us about proper worship. Bring your questions, as well.
