## **Preparation for Paintball**

Paintball will be played in a heavy wooded area with underbrush, various plant life and/or on an island including the same. (flip flops or sandals will not be allowed)

- A full faced helmet that covers the face and ears is provided by the camp and must be worn at all times while on the course.
- Only Paintball markers and paintballs provided by the camp will be used.
- Rules of play will be given before participation and expected to be followed. Failure to follow rules will result in immediate ejection from the course.
